MINUTES FROM THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Thursday, October 18, 2012

- CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Christopher Sabec, Chair. Members
 present were Steve Rebscher, Christopher Sabec, Meegan Ochs-Potter, and Denise Santa Cruz-Bohman.
 Richard Sloan was excused. Also present were Larry Enos, Superintendent, Bruce Abbott, Business
 Manager and Laura Shain, Principal. Donna Henderson recorded the minutes.
- 2. APPROVAL OF CLOSED SESSION AGENDA: Board Members approved the Closed Session Agenda.
- 3. PUBLIC COMMENTS ON CLOSED SESSION AGENDA: There were no comments.
- 4. RECESS TO CLOSED SESSION: Board Members recessed to Closed Session at 5:05 p.m., pursuant to Section 54957 Public Employee Discipline/Dismissal/Release, Requested by Larry Enos, Superintendent.
