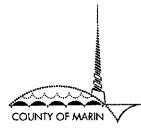

Dear Investment Fund Participants:

The attached Monthly Report of County, Schools and District investments is provided for your review.

- * The investments were made pursuant to Government Code Sections 53601, 53635 and comply with the County Treasurer's Statement of Investment Policy. The investment policy provides for:
 - Preservation of capital through high quality investments;
 - Maintenance of sufficient liquidity to meet participant operating needs; and
 - A rate of return consistent with the above objectives.
- * Maturities are scheduled to meet participant expenditure requirements for the next six months.
- * Attached spreadsheets identify investment type, issuer, maturity date, amount invested and fair market value for each security held. Fair market values were determined by Wells Fargo Institutional Trust Services on all securities except for investments in the Local Agency Investment Fund which was valued at face value by us. Adjustments have been made for premiums, discounts and accrued interest on discount securities to make the book value and fair market value more comparable.

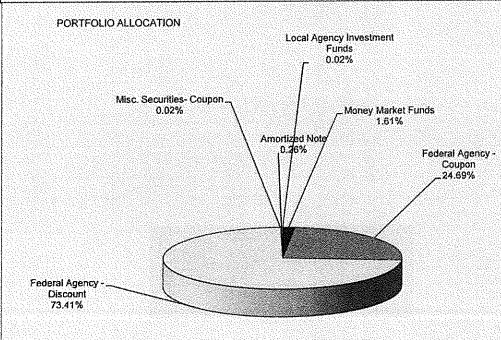

- 3. PUBLIC COMMENTS ON CLOSED SESSION AGENDA: There were no comments.
- 4. RECESS TO CLOSED SESSION: Board Members and Administration recessed to Closed Session pursuant to Ed. Code Section 54957.6 Conference with Labor Negotiator, John Carroll, Certificated, Classified, and Management/Confidential, requested by John Carroll, Superintendent and pursuant to Section 54957: Public Employee Discipline/Dismissal/Release, requested by John Carroll, Superintendent.
- 5. RECONVENE INTO OPEN SESSION (Room 20, Lagunitas School): The Board of Trustees reconvened at 6:10 p.m. The Chair announced that no reportable action was taken in Closed Session.
- 6. PUBLIC COMMENTS: Dave Cort, Director of the SGVCC, announced that the annual Talent Show will take place on March 17th in the multi-purpose room on the Lagunitas school campus. There will be a fundraising event for the community center at the Lagunitas Brewing Company on Tuesday, April 10th from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m.
- 7. APPROVAL OF OPEN SESSION AGENDA: Denise Bohman moved to approve, Steve Rebscher, second. Motion carried, 3 ayes.
- 8. INTRODUCTIONS: Introductions were made; there were approximately 15 members of the public in attendance.

LONG RANGE PLAN: Sarah Fisk, Facilitator, gave an overview of the planning work that has been done so far. She has been meeting with John Carroll, Superintendent, Richard Sloan, Board President, and Trustee Steve Rebscher. Members of the audience gave input to the planning charts that she presented.

BOARD MEMBER REPORTS:

- a. Trustee Denise Bohman asked that when the board meeting is adjourned it should be in honor to those staff and students who were massacred at Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, Florida on February 14th.
- b. Trustee Steve Rebscher reported that he has been working in negotiations with LTA and also with the planning committee for the Long Range Plan.
- c. Trustee Richard Sloan announced that the San Geronimo School playground is 99% complete.

10. ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS:

- a. John Carroll, Superintendent, informed the Board that he has recently attended conferences—a Math Leadership Conference in Stanford with Jo Boles, and a Masters In Governance training, presented by the California School Boards Association.
- b. Laura Shain, Principal, reminded the audience of the 3 upcoming productions for each of the programs.
- c. Jeff Lippstreu, CBO, has been working with the staff at the Marin County Office of Education in their review of the District's First Interim Report. The Facilities Committee meets again near the end of March. Alejandro Alvarado, District Maintenance person, has been doing great things in the school garden.
- 11. REPORTS "What Works". A report on practices that have the highest impact on student learning was postponed until the March meeting.
- 12. CORRESPONDENCE/INFORMATION ITEMS: Board Members reviewed the enrollment update of February, 2018, the letter of January 16, 2018 from the Marin County Office of Education regarding the District's First Interim Report, the Certification of Corrective Action, 2016/17 Audit Findings from the Marin County Office of Education, the Kraven Committee recommendation for Middle School Science for the 2017/18 school year, and the Performance Indicator Review, prepared by Laura Shain, Principal, for the California Department of Education regarding our Special Education Program.

- 1. DEFICIT SPENDING REDUCTION PLAN: John Carroll, Superintendent, announced that the district budget is looking better and that the deficit might be considerably lower than projected. Background: Both of the California pension systems into which the Lagunitas School District contributes will be implementing substantial increases in employer contributions over the next several years. The CalSTRS employer contribution rate will grow from 14.43% in 2017 to 19.01% in 2020. The CalPERS employer contribution rate will grow from 15.531% in 2017 to 22.7% in 2020.

Those cost increases are legally mandated and have been communicated to the district in advance. Creating a special reserve is intended to cover this cost of those increases for the next two years.

Recommendation: Approve the designation of a Special Reserve of \$59,067 for STRS/ PERS increases in anticipation of increased employer contributions to CalPERS and CalSTRS.

Lagunitas Elementary School provides a safe and clean environment for learning through proper facilities maintenance and campus supervision. The Lagunitas School District passed a \$5 million dollar bond in November 2013 for the modernization of the Lagunitas & San Geronimo Schools. The final projects of the classrooms and offices were completed in January 2017. Ongoing maintenance and improvements to ensure compus facilities remain up to date and provide adequate space and a healthy environment for students and staff.

Campus Maintenance

Lagunitas Elementary School staff is proud of the beautiful campus and is devoted to maintaining high standards regarding campus maintenance and general housekeeping practices. The Lagunitas School District's custodial staff is qualified and equipped to handle routine cleaning needs, general maintenance, and minor repairs. Following a standard cleaning schedule, two full-time day custodians and one maintenance worker are responsible for the upkeep of both; Lagunitas & San Geronimo Schools. The maintenance worker is responsible for general grounds keeping and minor repairs; target projects are typically outsourced to third party contractors. The custodian is responsible for deily cleaning of the Cafeteria/multi-purpose room, classrooms, offices and restrooms. Teachers communicate unscheduled maintenance needs and special projects requests to the secretary who prepares a work order and forwards it to the Chief Business Official (CBO), for review and approval. The CBO assigns the work order to the custodian/maintenance worker or mekes arrangements for a third party contractor to fulfill the request. Emergency situations ere given high priority and resolved immediately by either the custodial staff or maintenance worker.

Every morning before school begins, maintenance inspects school facilities for safety hazards and maintenance issues that require attention before staff and students arrive on campus. Any graffiti or signs of vandalism are removed immediately. Restrooms are checked periodically as a proactive measure in keeping facilities safe, sanitary, and stocked.

The principal and school staff continually monitor the campus and its surrounding areas as a proactive measure in keeping facilities safe and clean. Schools are required on an annual basis to conduct a formal inspection of designated ereas and systems as required by state law to report the condition of their facilities. Lagunitas Elementary School's most recent inspection took place on January 28, 2017; the School Facility Good Repair Status table is illustrated.

Deferred Maintenance

Lagunilas School District does not participate in the State School Deferred Maintenance Program and does not receive any funding to assist with major repairs or replacement of existing school building components. These components include but are not limited to, roofing, plumbing, electrical systems, playground structures, and exterior painting. The District's Board of Trustees and Administration understand the need to fund the District's Deferred Maintenance program; therefore, funds from the general fund are transferred into the Deferred Meintenance fund to cover the cost for repairs and other general maintenance. In fiscal year 2017-18 the Deferred Maintenance fund budgeted \$90,500 and to date has expended \$28,867 of these funds for painting, repairs to fencing
